•Display of achievement in various assessment, attendence of the student through charts.

•If the attendance of the students stands more 60% they are mark with **green color**, below 60% above 40% they are mark at **yellow** and below 40% they are mark with **red color**.

•All the colors has been inspired from the colors of traffic rules.

•**Red color** indicates the danger zone needs special attention.

•Yellow color indicates extra precaution that needs huge improvement.

•Green color indicates the sincerity. Each chart is supported with the photographs of the student to make it more attractive.





• Jogipali UP School:

• A Content CD mapping basing upon the subject & Class is also prepared to help the teachers to guide the students.




Jayantpur UP School:
