**Decision taken by the Selection Board for calculation of Career assessment marks**

❖ The recruitment guidelines of NHM vide letter nos 9150 dated 29.02.15 and 10468 dated 26/08/15 it is clearly mentioned that career assessment for staff nurses will be as follows

**For SNCU staffs**

Sl No	Examination	Weightage
i.	HSC (Excluding 4 <sup>th</sup> optional/equivalent	20%
ii	+2 Science (excluding 4 <sup>th</sup> optional)/ equivalent	30%
iii	B.Sc Nursing/ Diploma in General Nursing & Midwife Course	50%

**For ANM**

Sl No	Examination	Weightage
i.	HSC (Excluding 4 <sup>th</sup> optional/equivalent	20%
ii	+2 (excluding 4 <sup>th</sup> optional)/ equivalent	30%
iii	B.Sc Nursing/ Diploma in General Nursing & Midwife Course	50%

The committee decided to allot '0' (Zero) marks to +2 (Other than Science stream) students for staff nurses where as for ANM candidates will be considered for science and other than science stream.

**Example of calculation of marks**

{An applicant X has secured marks as follows

HSC- 380 out of 600

+2- 305 out of 600

GNM- 1350 out of 1900

Career assessment percentage=

$$((380/600)*100)*0.2+((305/600)*100)*.3+((1350/1900)*100*.5 =12.67+15.25+35.53=63.15}$$

**For SAMPURNA**

❖ The committee agreed to the point that since SAMPURNA is a specific programme the criteria for In- House will not be applicable and all posts will come under open selection. In all other cases In house NHM candidates will be given preference.
