NB: 1) Moreover 4% of the total vacancy shall be reserved for persons with different ability, 3% for Ex Servicemen & 1% for sport persons.

2) People with Different Ability (HI, VI and OH), Ex-Servicemen and Sports Persons will be selected from the concerned category he/she belongs to.

**01. COMMON ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

For the post of Teaching Staff, an applicant must

- Be a citizen of India.
- Be a Permanent Resident of Odisha.

- (c) Not have more than one spouse living.
- (d) Be of good character and furnish the copy of character certificate issued from Head of the Institution last studied.
- (e) Not be less than 21 (Twenty One) years and not more than 32 (Thirty Two) years of age as on 01-01-2020. The upper age limit shall be relaxed by 5 (Five) years for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/SEBC/Women category, 10 (Ten) years for persons with different ability and by total period of service rendered in defense service in case of Ex-Servicemen. However a candidate can avail only one type of age relaxation as per rules.
- (f) Have registered his/her name in the Employment Exchange.
- (g) Be able to read and write Odia. Any one of the following qualification will be taken into consideration to ascertain this ability of the candidate.
  - i. He / She must have passed HSC Examination conducted by Board of Secondary Education, Odisha or equivalent examination conducted by any other State Board or Central Board ( Like CBSE, ICSE) with Odia as a Language Subject i.e. First/ Second/ Third Language.
  - ii. He/ She must have passed +2/ Higher Secondary Examination conducted by the council of Higher Secondary Education, Odisha or equivalent examination conducted by any other State Board or Central Board (Like CBSE, ICSE) with Odia as an examinable subject.
  - iii. He must have passed Odia Examination of HSC/ Tenth standard conducted by BSE, Odisha.
  - iv. In case of candidates desirous for Language Teacher post like Hindi Teacher / Sanskrit Teacher, passing Odia Examination in ME standard conducted by BSE, Odisha may be allowed.
- (h) Have qualified OSSTET (ODISHA SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS ELIGIBILITY TEST)

- A. The Science Graduate Candidates should have passed with two school subjects (with not less than 200 marks each) as follows:
- Trained Science Graduate (PCM): Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics
  - Trained Science Graduate (CBZ): Chemistry, Botany, Zoology.
- B. For the Arts Graduate Candidates, one of the subject shall be considered out of English, Odia, Hindi and Sanskrit and another subject shall be considered out of History, Geography, Economics, Political Science, Indian Economy, Landmarks in Indian History, Indian Geography, Indian Polity (Each subject of the above mentioned list should have been studied at the graduation level with not less than 200 marks).

**03. DOCUMENTS TO BE ENCLOSED WITH THE APPLICATION FORM:**

#### **04. SELECTION PROCEDURE:**

The basis for preparation of the selection list shall be the marks obtained by the candidates in different examinations starting from HSC Examination or equivalent up to the minimum qualification required for the post as per the prevailing guideline.

The application received after the last date will not be considered. The authority will not be responsible for any postal delay.

**06. TERMS & CONDITIONS:**

- (a) The remuneration for the post of TGT-Arts & TGT-Science is Rs 16,880/- (Rupees Sixteen Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty) only per month.
- (b) The remuneration for the post of Hindi Teacher is Rs. 16,880/- (Rupees Sixteen Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty) only per month.
- (c) The remuneration for the post of Sanskrit Teacher is Rs. 16, 880/- (Rupees Sixteen Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty) only per month.
- (d) The remuneration for the post of PET is Rs.16,880/- (Rupees Sixteen Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty) only per month for candidates having BP Ed and Rs 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) only per month for candidates having CP Ed.
