

2. In order to select participants who will be featured in the Pariksha Pe Charcha, an online Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) competition is being conducted at <https://innovateindia1.mygov.in/> from 14th December, 2024 to 14th January 2025 for children studying in classes from 6 to 12, teachers and parents. All the participants will receive a participation Certificate.

3. This competition is the mode through which we invite students, parents and teachers to frame their questions to be addressed to the Hon'ble Prime Minister. Selected questions, shortlisted by NCERT, may feature in the programme. - d. Hold meetings with your Regional Offices within this week to ensure wide dissemination at all levels.
 - e. Prepare your own media plan for ensuring dissemination and participation.
 - f.
