**EXPRESSION OF INTEREST TO PROVIDE QUOTATION FOR SUPPLY,

PASSENGER ELEVATOR (HOME LIFT) AT ASHOK NIWAS, BURLA**

TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. Introduction about Ashok Niwas:

The Hirakud Dam project is built across river Mahanadi about 15 km upstream of Sambalpur town in the state of Odisha and was commissioned in the year 1957. It is a Multipurpose project and is the longest earthen dam in Asia having a total length of 25.8 Km. It is a composite dam of earth, concrete, and masonry. Ashok Niwas is located adjoining the Nehru Minar of Hirakud Dam. It is a two storied luxury guest house.

2. Scope of the EOI

This EOI is not an agreement or an offer by the Authority to the prospective applicants or any other person. The purpose of this EOI is to provide interested parties with information that may be useful to them in the formulation & submission of their applications pursuant to this EOI. The scope of the contract shall be for quotations to provide equipments / materials as per the specifications at the consignee's site, and rendering services in accordance with the enclosed **technical specifications**.

2. Manner of supply

All equipments / materials to be supplied shall be manufactured in the manner, set out in the specification or where not set out, to the reasonable satisfaction of the Purchaser's representative.

3. Site particulars

Suppliers / Manufacturers are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their offer as to nature of works, site conditions, means of access to the site etc. Non-familiarity with site condition will not be considered a reason either for extra claims or for not carrying out the work in strict conformity with the specification for site visit and any clarification / information Assistance, the intending supplier / manufacturers may contact Superintending Engineer, Main Dam Division, Burla, Sambalpur, Odisha.

4. Inspection and Testing

- i. The purchaser's representative shall, if desired / felt necessary, be entitled at all reasonable times during manufacture to inspect, examine and test at the supplier's premises, the materials and workmanship of all elevators / lifts materials to be supplied under this contract and if part of the said elevators / lifts is being manufactured in other premises, the supplier shall obtain for the purchaser's representative permission to inspect, examine and test as if the equipment were being manufactured in the supplier's premises. Such inspection, examination and testing shall not release the supplier from his obligations under the contract.

- ii. The Supplier shall give to the purchaser adequate time / notice in writing for inspection of materials indicating the place at which the elevators / lifts material is ready for testing and inspection and shall also furnish the shop Routine Test Certificate, Calibration Certificates of Testing elevators / lifts calibrated in Govt. approved laboratory with authenticity letter of that laboratory along with the offer for inspection. A packing list along with the offer, indicating the quantity which can be delivered in full truck load / Mini truck load to facilitate issue of dispatch instruction shall also be furnished.
- iii. Where the contract provides for test at the Premises of the supplier or any of his sub - vendors, the supplier shall provide such assistance, labour, materials, electricity, fuel and instruments, as may be required or as may be reasonably demanded by the Purchaser's representative to carry out such tests efficiently. The supplier is required to produce shop routine test Certificate, calibration certificates of Testing elevators / lifts before offering their materials elevators / lifts for inspection & testing. The test house / laboratory where tests are to be carried out must be approved by the Govt. A letter pertaining to Govt. approved laboratory must be furnished to the purchaser along with the offer for inspection.
- iv. After completion of the tests, the Purchaser's representative shall forward the test results to the Purchaser. If the test results conform to the specific standard and specification, the Purchaser shall approve the test results and communicate the same to the supplier in writing. The supplier shall provide at least five copies of the test certificates to the Purchaser.
- v. The Purchaser has the right to have the tests carried out at his own cost by an independent agency whenever there is dispute regarding the quality of supply.
- vi. If the Firm fails to present the offered items for inspection / testing as per their inspection call due to any reasons during the visit of the inspecting officer at the testing site, the Firm have to bear all expenses towards the repetition of inspection / testing of the total offered quantity or part thereof.

5. Training facilities

The supplier shall provide all possible facilities for training of Purchaser's Technical personnel, when deputed by the Purchaser for acquiring firsthand knowledge in assembly of the elevator / lift, its erection, commissioning and for its proper operation and maintenance in service, wherein it is thought necessary by the purchaser.

6. Rejection of Materials

In the event any of the elevators / lifts materials, provided by the manufacturer is found defective due to faulty design, bad workmanship, bad materials used or otherwise not in conformity with the requirements of the Specification, the Purchaser shall either reject the elevator / lift or ask the supplier in writing to rectify or replace the defective lift free of cost to the purchaser. The supplier on receipt of such notification shall either rectify or replace the defective lift free of cost to the purchase within **15** days from the date of issue of such notification by the purchaser. If the supplier fails to do so, the Purchaser may:-

- a) At its option replace or rectify such defective lift / elevator materials and recover the extra costs so involved from the supplier plus fifteen percent and / or.
- b) Terminate the contract for balance supplies, with enforcement of penalty Clause as per contract for the undelivered goods and with forfeiture of Performance security.
- c) Acquire the defective lift / elevator materials at reduced price, considered equitable under the circumstances.

7. Experience & Eligibility Criteria of Supplier

The bidders should furnish information regarding experience particularly on the following points:

- i) The bidders should be an authorized partner having a direct purchase and support agreement with Origin of Lift Manufacture (OLM)
- ii) A letter of authorization from the principal specific to the tender should be enclosed.
- iii) Bidder shall be submitted an annual Turnover of **Rs.1.00 (One corer)** in any one year of the last 2 financial years certified by CA.
- iv) The bidder should have availability of service engineer and or service center operating in and around Bhubaneswar / Sambalpur. Communication address and telephone numbers for the same should be provided.
- v) The bidder should have an experience of supplying proposed lift / elevator to reputed Indian organizations Govt. or Department of Water Resources or Central Ministry or other research organizations etc. The details of such supplies for the preceding three years should be given with details. Copies of purchase orders must be enclosed along with Techno Commercial Bid.
- vi) The bidder will have to submit an undertaking stating that they will not be outsourcing any work specified in this expression of interest document to any other party.
- vii) A list of purchase orders of identical lift / elevator materials offered as per technical specification executed during the last three years along with users certificate. User's certificate shall be legible and must indicate user's name, address, designation, place of use, and satisfactory performance of the lift / elevator materials for at least three years from the date of commissioning.



- viii) Bidder will have to submit the valid GTS Registration certificate, PAN Card and certificate of registration under company act/ Partnership.

8. Criteria for the Original Lift Manufacturer (OLM) the product

- i) The OLM of the lifts being quoted by the bidder may have presence in India for more than 3 years.
- ii) OLM should have members participating in international/ National standard bodies like ISO/IEC/EIA/TIA or any international standard body etc.
- iii) The principal vendor should have local offices in India.
- iv) The principal of the bidder should have 24 x 7 technical assistance centre in India and bidders must have service centers or their own in India with engineers qualified to handle the repair and maintenance work.

9. Instructions to Bidders for submission of bids

The interested Agencies/Bidders may submit their hard copies in sealed envelopes for Technical and Financial bids separately and combined both in 3rd envelope to addressing to **Superintending Engineer, Main Dam Division, Burla, PO-Burla, Pin-768017, Sambalpur, Odisha** on or before **16.01.2025** up to **4.00 PM**. EoI inviting authority shall not assume any responsibility for any delayed in submission of the said proposal.

10. Language and measures

All documents pertaining to the contract including specifications, schedule, notices, correspondence, operating and maintenance instructions, drawings or any other writing shall be written in English language. The metric system of measurement shall be used exclusively.

11. Deviation from specification

It is in the interest of the Supplier to study the specifications, specified in the Expression of Interest thoroughly before quoting the rates. So that, if any deviations are made by the SUPPLIER (both commercial and Technical), the same are prominently brought out on a separate sheet under heading "Deviations Commercial" and "Deviations Technical". A list of deviations shall be enclosed with the tender. Unless deviations in scope, technical and commercial stipulations are specifically mentioned in the list of deviations, it shall be presumed that the SUPPLIER has accepted all the conditions, stipulated in the tender specification, notwithstanding any exemptions mentioned therein.

12. Patent rights

The supplier shall indemnify the Purchaser against all claims, actions, suits and proceedings for the infringement of any patent design or copy right protected either in the country of origin or in India by the use of any lift / elevator supplied by the manufacturer. Such indemnity shall also cover any use of the equipment, other than for the purpose indicated by or reasonably to be inferred from the specification.

13. Delivery

Time being the essence of the contract; the lift / elevator shall be supplied within the delivery period to be specified in the contract. The Purchaser, however, reserves the right to reschedule the delivery and change the destination if required. The delivery period shall be reckoned from the date of placing the Letter of Intent / Purchase order, as may be specified in LOI / Purchase order.

14. Dispatch instructions

- i. The lift / elevator should be securely packed and dispatched directly to the specified site at the supplier's risk.
- ii. **Loading & unloading of Ordered Materials.**
It will be the sole responsibility of the supplier for loading and unloading of materials both at the factory site and at the destination site / store.
- iii. The Purchaser shall have no responsibility on this account

15. Supplier's Default Liability

- i. The Purchaser may, upon written notice of default to the supplier, terminate the contract in circumstances detailed hereunder.
 - a) If in the judgment of the Purchaser, the supplier fails to make delivery of all lift / elevator material within the time specified in the contract or within the period for which if extension has been granted by the Purchaser in writing in response to written request of the supplier.
 - b) If in the judgment of the Purchaser, the supplier fails to comply with any of the provisions of this contract.
- ii) In the event, Purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part and the Purchaser reserves the right to purchase upon such terms and in such a manner as he may deem appropriate in relation to the lift / elevator similar to that terminated and the supplier will be liable to the Purchaser for any additional costs for such similar lift / elevator material and or for penalty for delay as defined in clause-19 of this section until such reasonable time as may be required for the final supply of lift / elevator.

16. Extension of time

If the delivery of lift / elevator is delayed due to reasons beyond the control of the supplier, the supplier shall without delay give notice to the purchaser in writing of his claim for an extension of time. The purchaser on receipt of such notice may or may not agree to extend the contract delivery date as may be reasonable but without prejudice to other terms and conditions of the contract.

17. Guarantee period

The stores (lift / elevator) covered by this specification should be guaranteed for satisfactory operation and against defects in design, materials and workmanship for a period of at least 36 [thirty six] months from the date of commissioning after receipt of equipment/material along with free service for an additional period of 24 months including calibration and testing so as to assure trouble free performance beyond the guarantee period. During the free service period the cost of spare parts to be replaced will be made as per prevailing price list of the company. The above guarantee certificate shall be furnished in triplicate to the purchaser for his approval. Any defect noticed during this period should be rectified /replaced by the supplier free of cost to the purchaser provided such defects are due to faulty design, bad workmanship or bad materials used, within one month upon written notice from the purchaser failing which provision of **clause 19 (ii)** shall apply.

18. Security deposit and performance guarantee

- i) To ensure the performance of the contract, performance security is to be obtained from the successful bidder awarded with the contract. Performance security for an amount of 10% (ten percent) of the value of the contract shall be furnished in the form of NSC / KVP / Post Office Saving Account / Post Office Term Deposit Account / Bank Guarantee / Demand Draft in favour of the Divisional Officer from any Nationalized Scheduled Bank in India Counter Guaranteed by a local Branch / Post Office etc. safe guarding the purchaser's interest in all respects.
- ii) Performance security should remain valid for a period of 60 days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the supplier including guarantee and free service obligations.
- iii) Bid security should be refunded to the successful bidder on receipt of performance security.
- iv) Performance security will be released @5% on each completed year of the free service period for two years.
- v) In case of non-fulfillment of contractual obligation, as required in the detail purchase order / specification, the security deposit shall be forfeited.

19. Import License

In case imported materials are offered, no assistance will be given for release of Foreign Exchange. The firm should arrange to import lift from their own quota lift / elevator of indigenous origin will be preferred. The foreign exchange, costume duty if etc if any will not be borne by the purchaser at any cost.

20. Terms of Payment

(i) 85% of the contract value shall be released in favour of the supplier after supply of the entire consignment in good condition at stores / desired site, installation, testing, satisfactory commissioning of the passenger and lift / elevator and imparting training for operation. The balance 15% of the contract value shall be released @5% on each completed year for the first three years.

(ii) **Payment of Freight & Insurance charges and Entry Tax.**

The quoted rate put by the bidder shall be inclusive of all taxes like GST, excise duty and costume duty etc.

21. Penalty for Delay in Completion of Contract

- I. If the Supplier fails to deliver the passenger lift / elevator within the delivery schedule, specified in the contract including delivery time extension, if any, granted thereto, the Purchaser shall recover from the Supplier, penalty for a sum of half percent (0.5 percent) of the Basic price of the un-delivered lift / elevator for each calendar week of delay or part thereof.

For this purpose, the date of received challan shall be reckoned as the date of delivery. The total amount of penalty shall not exceed five percent (5%) of the basic price of the unit or units so delayed. Equipment will be deemed to have been delivered only when all its components and accessories as per technical Specification are also delivered. If certain components & accessories are not delivered in time, the equipment will be considered delayed until such time as the missing parts are delivered.

- II If the Supplier fails to rectify / replace the lift / elevator within 30 days from the date of intimation of the defect, so noticed by the purchaser within the guarantee period then the penalty for sum of one half of the one percent (0.5%) of the total Purchase order amount for each calendar week of delay shall be recovered by the purchaser within the guarantee period.

For this purpose, penalty date will start from the 30th day from the date of issue of letter on defectiveness of lift / elevator, so supplied, by the purchaser. The total amount of penalty in this case shall not exceed 10% (TEN PERCENT) of the purchase order amount. If the defects so intimated will not be rectified by the supplier within the guarantee period, then whole of the performance security will be forfeited by the purchaser, without any intimation to the Supplier.

22. Insurance

The Supplier shall undertake insurance of stores covered by this Specification unless otherwise stated. The responsibility of delivery of the stores at destination in good condition rests with the Supplier. Any claim with the Insurance Company or transport agency arising due to loss or damage in transit has to be settled by the supplier. The Supplier shall undertake free replacement of materials damaged or lost, which will be reported by the consignee within 30 days of receipt of the materials at destination without awaiting for the settlement of their claims with the carriers and underwriters.

23. Validity

Prices and conditions contained in the offer should be kept valid for a minimum period of 90 (Ninety) days from the date of opening of the tender, failing which the tender shall be rejected.

The Quoted Price shall consist of the following components except GST APPLICABLE

- a. Ex-works price.
- b. Packing & Forwarding charges.
- c. Freight
- d. Insurance.
- e. Excise Duty/ costume duty (if a foreign material).
- f. Other levies.
- g. Mandatory spares, if any for maintenance of equipment. (At the discretion of the purchaser)
- h. Test & Calibration charges, if any.
- i. Erection, testing and commissioning and training charges, if any.
- j. Any other items, such as guarantee card and undertaking form for maintenance beyond guarantee period.

(ii). Expression of Interest of AMC for 5 years (optional)

Expression of Interest may also state the cost of annual maintenance contract for 5 years beyond guarantee period, if applicable (in steps of one year) after warranty (optional).

24. Jurisdiction of the High Court of Orissa

Legal issues / 'Suits, if any, arising out of this contract shall be filed by either Party in a court of Law to which the jurisdiction of High court of Orissa extends.

26. Force Majeure

The supplier shall not be liable for any penalty for delay or for failure to perform the contract for reasons of force majeure such as acts of god, acts of the public enemy, acts of Govt., Fires, floods, epidemics, Quarantine restrictions, strikes, Freight Embargo and provided that the supplier shall within Ten (10) days from the beginning of delay on such account notify the purchaser in writing of the cause of delay. The purchaser shall verify the facts and grant such extension, if facts justify.

27. Extension of time

If the delivery of equipment / material is delayed due to reasons beyond the control of the supplier, the supplier shall without delay give notice to the purchaser in writing of his claim for an extension of time. 




