**2<sup>nd</sup> Corrigendum Notice**

In partial modification of the Tender Call Inviting Notice No. F & E/RKL/017 (OFFLINE)/2026-27, dated 04.06.2026 for " **Design, development, deployment, training and maintenance of an integrated Nursery Management System (web + mobile) and a Forest Management system cum GIS Dashboard and field mobile application**" in Redhakhhol Forest Division" during the year 2026-27, issued by the Divisional Forest Officer, Redhakhhol, The following amendments / clarifications are hereby notified. The amendments set out below shall be read as part of, and in modification of, the said RFP. Prospective bidders are therefore requested to visit the official website for further updates in this regard through [www.redhakhholforest.com](http://www.redhakhholforest.com), or <https://sambalpur.odisha.gov.in> or [www.odishaforest.in](http://www.odishaforest.in). The details of modifications are set out below.

**1. Estimated Cost of the Project (New insertion — Tender Fact Sheet)**

The following entry shall be inserted in the Tender Fact Sheet (Critical Information) of the RFP:

**Estimated Cost of the Project: Rs. 20.00 Lakh (Rupees Twenty Lakh only).**

**2. Integrated Solution Architecture (Clause 4.1 — Solution Overview)**

**Existing:** The assignment comprises two functionally distinct components — Component A (Nursery Management System: web portal + mobile app) and Component B (GIS Dashboard cum mobile application).

**Amended — read as:** The Nursery Management System and the Forest Management System shall be integrated into one (1) unified Web portal together with two (2) dedicated mobile applications, the whole solution operating under a common Role-Based Access Control (RBAC) framework and a single shared identity across all surfaces. The system should design in such a way for future applications in the portal

**3. On-Premise Large Language Model (Clause 6.1 and allied references)**

**Existing:** Use of open-source / open-weight model families such as Qwen, Gemma and Llama (and equivalents), served locally.

**Amended — read as:** The on-premise Large Language Model shall be GLM 5.2 or similar weight models, locally hosted and quantized appropriately to suit the Division's / State server hardware. The design shall remain model-agnostic and configurable so that the model may be upgraded without re-engineering the application.

**4. Customizability & Circle-wide Scalability (Clause 4.4 — Cross-cutting requirements)**

The solution shall be completely customizable and shall be architected for horizontal scalability, such that it can be extended / replicated across the entire Sambalpur Circle, without re-engineering, by configuration alone. The Agency shall design data models, RBAC, masters and deployment to accommodate multiple Divisions of the Circle.

## 6. Encouragement to Start-ups (Section 7 — Eligibility Criteria)

Start-ups are encouraged to apply. Due relaxation in the eligibility conditions (including, as applicable, years of operation, minimum annual turnover, prior experience and Earnest Money / bid security) shall be granted to eligible Start-ups as per existing rules, in line with the prevailing Government of Odisha / Government of India and OGFR provisions for procurement from Start-ups and MSEs. Start-ups are required to submit required Certificates in the Technical Bid.

## 7. New Module — Customizable Drone Flight Management (Addition to Section 4 — Scope of Work, Component B)

The Scope of Work shall be augmented to include an additional, fully customizable Drone Flight Management module within the Forest Management System cum GIS application. The module shall provide, at minimum, the following functionality:

- Flight register & tracking — a digital register that records and tracks every drone (UAV) flight conducted in the Division, capturing date, time, range / section / site, pilot / operator, drone model and key flight parameters (area covered, altitude, duration), with map view of flight locations.
- Purpose of flight — capture of the purpose of each flight (e.g. plantation mapping, fire monitoring, elephant / wildlife monitoring, boundary & encroachment survey, orthomosaic generation, etc.) selected from a configurable, administrator-maintainable list.
- Unique Flight Code — automatic generation of a unique, non-repeating Flight Code for every flight (configurable encoding scheme, e.g. range / date / serial), used as the key reference for that flight across the entire system.
- Data-uploading portal — a portal through which all flight outputs and deliverables (raw imagery, orthomosaics, KML / KMZ tracks, flight logs and reports) are uploaded and indexed against the corresponding Unique Flight Code, under the common RBAC framework, with offline capture and later synchronization where applicable.

The module shall be customizable and shall conform to the same architecture, security, RBAC, on-premise hosting and interoperability requirements specified for the solution. Bidders shall account for this module in their technical and financial bids.

## 8. Revised QCBS Weightage (Section 9 — Evaluation Methodology)

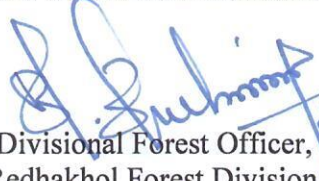
**Existing:** Technical and financial weightages are 40% and 60% respectively;  $S = (0.40 \times T) + (0.60 \times F_n)$ .

**Amended — read as:** Technical and financial weightages shall be 70% and 30% respectively. Accordingly, the combined (composite) score shall be computed as:

$$S = (0.70 \times T) + (0.30 \times F_n)$$

Where T = Technical score (out of 100) and  $F_n = (F_{min} \div F_{bid}) \times 100$  is the normalised financial score, as otherwise defined in Clause 9.2 of the RFP. All other parameters of Clause 9.2 remain unchanged.

**\*All other terms, conditions, specifications, annexures and stipulations of the original RFP (Ref. No. F & E/RKL/017 (OFFLINE)/2026-27 dated 04 June 2026) shall remain unchanged and in full force. This Corrigendum shall form an integral part of the RFP, and bidders are advised to read the RFP together with this Corrigendum before submitting their bids. Bidders who may have already submitted the tender document are required to re-submit with the above amendments.**
