3. Cost of Bid Documents/ Tender Paper: Cost of Bid Documents/ Tender Paper specified against each work in column 6 of table of N.I.T. The paper cost should be paid online in the portal in a single payment. The bidder is solely responsible for successful payment and he will not be able to participate in case of failure. Department of State Procurement Cell, NIC and designated Bank should not be held responsible or failure of payment by the bidder.

4. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD): Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) specified against each work in column 4 of table of N.I.T. The EMD should be paid online in the portal in a single payment. The bidder is solely responsible for successful payment and he will not be able to participate in case of failure. Department of State Procurement Cell, NIC and designated Bank should not be held responsible or failure of payment by the bidder.

5. The paving of roads shall be done on wall-to-wall basis, without leaving any soil on either side by fixing of 80mm thick cement concrete interlocking paver block of M-40 grades of approved make, design and size made by Block making machine with proper compaction conforming to IRC SP-63.2018

6. The DTCN condition cover concurrent of three years of defect liability period and maintenance period of the constructed roads to ensure qualitative work & good condition of road for at least 3 years period. In addition to that 10% Security deposit (2 % towards initial security deposit at the time of signing of the agreement +8% Security deposit to be deducted from running or final bill amount to cover the maintenance period of the roads), which shall be released to the Executing Agency@ 2% at the end of 1st year after completion of the Road, @3% at the end of 2nd year after completion of the Road and @5% at the end of 3rd year after completion of the Road. In case, the Executing Agency fails to maintain the road properly during the above mentioned three years period, the ULB shall incur expenditure and maintain the road at the cost and risk of the Executing Agency and the entire expenditure so incurred by the ULB shall be recovered from the 10% security deposit available with the ULB, apart from blacklisting of the contractor.

7. The specifications of the materials to be used and the defect liability period & maintenance period conditions as mentioned at Col. 5 & 6 above shall be part of the agreement, while assigning the work to the Executing Agencies.

8. The works should be executed following standard PWD specifications & IS code.

9. GST: The GST is applicable shall be payable to the contractor on each bill amount on production of tax invoice.

10. The Bid documents will be available in the website www.tendersorissa.gov.in from **10.00 A.M. of dt. 07.07.2026 to 06.00 P.M. of 27.07.2026** for online bidding.

11. The Bidder must possess compatible Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) of Class III

12. Bids shall be received only "on line" on or before **6:00 P.M. of 27.07.2026**

13. Bids received on line shall be opened at **11:30 AM on 28.07.2026** in the office of the undersigned in the presence of the bidders who wish to attend. Bidders who participated in the bid can witness the opening of bids after logging on to the site through their DSC. If the Office happens to be closed on the date of opening of the bids as specified, the bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.

14. All original documents along with affidavit of lowest bidder will be verified before issue of work order.

15. As per the Works Department Letter No. 5310 Dt. 02.05.2009 and letter No. 5140 Dt. 28.04.2009, Labour Cess @ 1 % (One percentage) will be deducted from the bill of the contractor.

16. Additional Performance Security (APS): Additional Performance Security (APS) should be submitted by the successful bidder when the accepted bid amount is less than the estimated cost put to tender in following manner.

It should be in shape of NSC/Post Office Savings Bank Account /Post Office Time Deposit Account/Kisan Vikash Patra/ Bank Guarantee from any nationalized schedule Bank in India counter-guaranteed by its local branch at Bhubaneswar/e-Bank Guarantee executed on the National e-Governance Services Limited (NeSL) (vide Works Department O.M. No. 1499 dt. 01.02.2023) duly pledged in favour of the Executive Officer, NAC, Redhakhol. The BG should remain valid at least till one month after expiry of stipulated date of completion of the work as per the contract.

17. Engineers Contractors who want to avail EMD exemption have to furnish one affidavit declaring therein to the effect that they have not yet availed three nos. of EMD exemption during the financial year and to show the original registration certificates to the tender opening authority for confirmation. Any bidders desirous to avail any facility as per certain circular/- orders of Govt. have to apply for the same in affidavit along with copy of the circular/-order.

18. The sealed Bid document shall contain scan copy of (a) Registration certificate, (b) PAN, (C) GST Registration certificate, (d) Cost of Tender Paper (Tender Fee) and EMD and other document required as per DTCN and special condition if any.

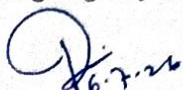
- Even if qualifying criteria are met, the bidders will be disqualified for the following reasons

- Past record of poor performance.
- Past record of abandoning the work half way / recession of contract.
- Past record of in-ordinate delay in start / Completion of the work.

- Past history of litigation.

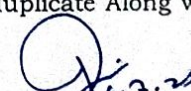
